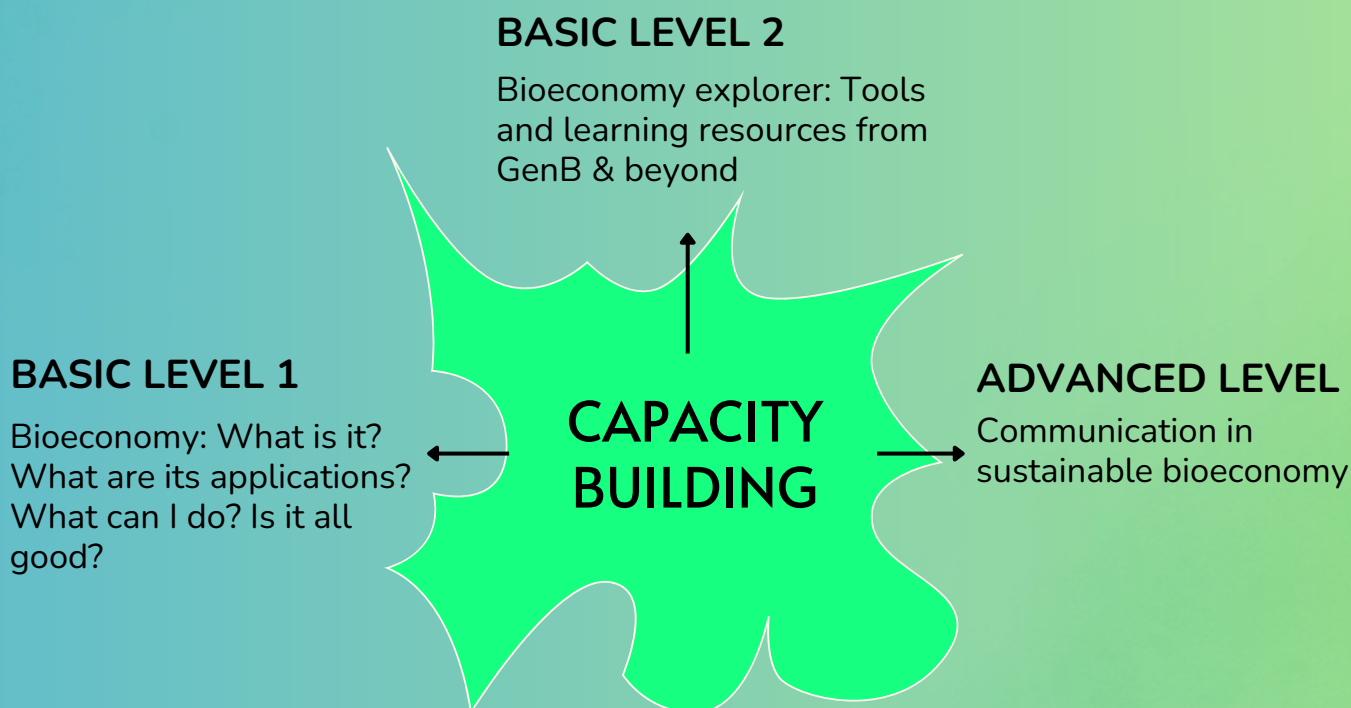


Overview

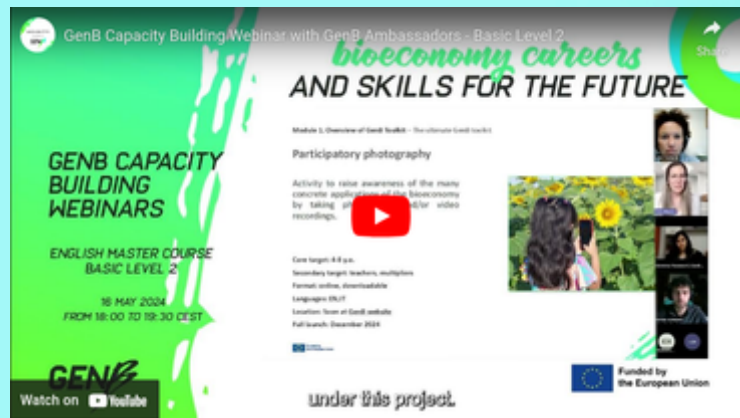
